| All owners of structures shall display and maintain in a conspicuous place on said structure, the assigned numbers in the following manner; |  |  |  |  |
| A.  | Number on the structure: where the structure is within fifty (50) feet from the edge of the road right-of-way, the assigned number shall be displayed on the front of the structure in the vicinity of the front door or entry.  |  |  |  |
| B.  | Number at the Street Line: where the structure is over fifty (50) feet from the edge of the road right-of-way, the assigned number shall be displayed on a post, fence, wall, mailbox, or on some structure at the property line adjacent to the walk or access drive to the numbered structure. |  |  |  |
| C.  | Size and color of Number: numbers shall be a minimum of four (4) inches high and be of contrasting color to its background.  |  |  |  |
| D.  | Old Numbers: every person whose duty is to display the assigned number shall remove any different number which might be mistaken for the number assigned in conformance with this ordinance.   |  |  |  |
| E.  | Interior location: all resident and other occupants are request to post their assigned number and road name on their telephone for emergency reference.  |  |  |  |
